

No Generational Curses

There are four categories of Scriptures about Generational Curses in the Bible:

- Before the Cross
- Prophetic Preview of the Cross
- At the Cross
- After the Cross

Before the Cross:

"I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me."

– Exodus 20:5 (NKJV)

"The Lord, the Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children and the children's children to the third and the fourth generation."

– Exodus 34:6-7 (NKJV)

"The Lord is longsuffering and abundant in mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression; but He by no means clears the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generation." – Numbers 14:18 (NKJV)

Prophetic Preview of the Cross:

"They also gave me gall for my food, and for my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink."

– Psalm 69:21 (NKJV)

"In those days they shall say no more: "The fathers have eaten sour grapes, and the children's teeth are set on edge." But every one shall die for his own iniquity; every man who eats the sour grapes, his teeth shall be set on edge. "Behold, the days are

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coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah.” – Jeremiah 31:29-31 (NKJV)

At the Cross:

“They gave Him sour wine mingled with gall to drink. But when He had tasted it, He would not drink.” – Matthew 27:34 (NKJV)

“Then someone ran and filled a sponge full of sour wine, put it on a reed, and offered it to Him to drink, saying, “Let Him alone; let us see if Elijah will come to take Him down.” – Mark 15:36 (NKJV)

“The soldiers also mocked Him, coming and offering Him sour wine.”
– Luke 23:36 (NKJV)

“Now a vessel full of sour wine was sitting there; and they filled a sponge with sour wine, put it on hyssop, and put it to His mouth. So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, “It is finished!” And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.”
– John 19:29-30 (NKJV)

After the Cross:

“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.” – 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NKJV)

“This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds I will write them.” Then He adds, “Their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more.”
– Hebrews 10:16-17 (NKJV)
