- God makes the unbeliever conscious of sin.
- God makes the believer conscious of righteousness.
- God makes Satan conscious of judgment.

"For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more." – Hebrews 8:12 (NKJV)

"Therefore by the deeds of the law no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the law is the knowledge of sin." – Romans 3:20 (NKJV)
