

I am the Righteousness of God in Jesus Christ

"In righteousness you shall be established." – Isaiah 54:14 (NKJV)

"For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so also by one Man's obedience many will be made righteous." – Romans 5:19 (NKJV)

"For He made Him Who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him." – 2 Corinthians 5:21 (NKJV)

"He leads me in the paths of righteousness [uprightness and right standing with Him—not for my earning it, but] for His name's sake." – Psalm 23:3 (AMPC)

"Surely in the Lord I have righteousness and strength." – Isaiah 45:24 (NKJV)

"I will greatly rejoice in the Lord, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness." – Isaiah 61:10 (NKJV)

"I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith."" – Romans 1:16-17 (NKJV)

"But now the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe." – Romans 3:21-22 (NKJV)

"But to him who does not work but believes on Him Who justifies the ungodly, his faith is accounted for righteousness, just as David also describes the blessedness of the man to whom God imputes righteousness apart from works." – Romans 4:5-6 (NKJV)

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"For the promise that he would be the heir of the world was not to Abraham or to his seed through the law, but through the righteousness of faith." – Romans 4:13 (NKJV)

"And when God counted him as righteous, it wasn't just for Abraham's benefit. It was recorded for our benefit, too, assuring us that God will also count us as righteous if we believe in Him, the One Who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead."

"For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ." – Romans 5:17 (NKJV)

"If Christ lives in you, [then although] your [natural] body is dead by reason of sin and guilt, the spirit is alive because of [the] righteousness [that He imputes to you]."
– Romans 8:10 (AMPC)

"Gentiles who did not follow after righteousness [who did not seek salvation by right relationship to God] have attained it by faith [a righteousness imputed by God, based on and produced by faith]." – Romans 9:30 (AMPC)

"If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation."
– Romans 10:9-10 (NKJV)

"But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, Who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption." – 1 Corinthians 1:30 (NKJV)

"In all things we commend ourselves as ministers of God: by the armor of righteousness on the right hand and on the left." – 2 Corinthians 6:4-7 (NKJV)

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"Abraham believed God, and God counted him as righteous because of his faith. The real children of Abraham, then, are those who put their faith in God. What's more, the Scriptures looked forward to this time when God would declare the Gentiles to be righteous because of their faith. God proclaimed this good news to Abraham long ago when He said, "All nations will be blessed through you." So all who put their faith in Christ share the same blessing Abraham received because of his faith."

"Simon Peter, a servant and apostle (special messenger) of Jesus Christ, to those who have received (obtained an equal privilege of) like precious faith with ourselves in and through the righteousness of our God and Savior Jesus Christ." – 2 Peter 1:1 (AMPC)

"My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous."
